FINAL ORDER

AND NOW, this 1st day of **November, 2022**, upon consideration of the credible testimony presented at the hearing held October 31, 2022 on Plaintiffs' Complaint in Equity and Motion for Injunctive Relief, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** injunctive relief is granted.

Defendants, as captioned, above, individually and jointly, together with their agents, officers, representatives, contractors, designees, members, and employees, or any other persons


acting in concert with them are **HEREBY ENJOINED, RESTRAINED, PROHIBITED, and PREVENTED**, from the following acts:

1. Stationing more than ten (10) in-motion pickets at any one time;
2. Crossing on or upon the area in which persons or motor vehicles enter from, or exit to West Wayne Street, at the specific area referred to as the "Rear Fenced Gate," where delivery and distribution vehicles, along with Butler Eagle employees, its agents, invitees, and contractors entering inside motor vehicles from, or exiting to West Wayne Street, a public right-of-way.
3. Blocking, obstructing, or picketing at the Butler Eagle facility at the Rear Fenced Gate area;
4. Threatening, harassing, intimidating or attempting to threaten, harass, intimidate, or unlawfully interfering, either directly or indirectly, with any person(s) or person(s) operating any motor vehicle entering or exiting, or attempting to enter or exit the Rear Fenced Gate area at the Butler Eagle facility;
5. Blocking, obstructing, or picketing anywhere in, on, or upon West Wayne Street, a public right-of-way;
6. Blocking, obstructing, or picketing anywhere in, on, or upon the public sidewalk on the South side of West Wayne Street in front of the residences across from the Butler Eagle facility;
7. Throwing any object(s) or attempting to throw any object(s) at any person or motor vehicle entering or exiting, or attempting to enter or exit the Rear Fenced Gate area at the Butler Eagle facility.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, Defendants, as captioned above, individually and jointly, together with their agents, officers, representatives, contractors, designees, members, and employees, together with any other persons acting in concert with them shall not be enjoined, restrained, prohibited, and prevented from lawfully and peacefully picketing on or along the public sidewalk on the North side of West Wayne Street adjacent to the Butler Eagle facility, subject to the restrictions set forth at Items 1-7, above.
